

PRE-SANITISING TREATMENT REQUIREMENTS

Congratulations on choosing to have your premises professionally sanitised!

To help make the sanitising process as seamless as possible please note the following:

- 1) Prior to your sanitising service:
 - For the treatment to be most effective, it is important to have your premises clean and tidy prior to sanitising.
 - Put away any food, eating and drinking crockery or utensils.
 - Put away or secure any loose paperwork.
 - If you have any fish or birds on the premises, we ask that you cover or remove them for at least 1 hour after the treatment.

- 2) The sanitising process:
 - On arrival, our technicians will introduce themselves and ask to be shown around the premises being treated.
 - A power supply will be required to operate the fogging equipment.
 - The technician will suit up in full protective clothing including a respirator.
 - Staff will need to vacate the premises while the fogging is taking place and should avoid entering the premises again for a minimum of 30 minutes following the treatment.
 - At the end of the treatment we can place our treatment sticker on your front door/window to let your customers know you have had your premises sanitised.
 - The icon/sticker is emailed to you so you can electronically let your customers know you have had your premises professionally sanitised.



Sanitising is a thorough, quick and cost-effective way of treating your entire premise. We use hospital grade TGA approved disinfectants that kill 99.999% of all bacteria, viruses and fungi whilst providing up to 30 days of continuous protection. The disinfectant is also safe for humans, pets, plants and food preparation areas.

Technicians use innovative commercial fogging equipment to disperse microscopic electrically charged droplets of hospital grade disinfectant targeted to all exposed surface areas within your premises.
